<b>Entry fees</b>	<b>30 € per player per event</b>  Entry fees must be paid in € at the tournament before the first scheduled match. Organizers don't accept credit or payments cards. If entry fees are not paid according to the regulations, the players concerned are not allowed to play. The member association that enters a player into a circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. For all the players withdrawing in the time between the entry and the beginning of the tournament the organizers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant member association.

In the events of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.</p> <p>The tournaments will be played in knock - out system</p> <p>Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they have entered.</p> <p>Competitors will be scratched if not ready to play when called. Therefore competitors should not leave the playing area during the tournament without the Referee's permission.</p> <p>Advertisement and Clothing Regulations: According to the BWF Competition Regulations reg. 19 to 23.</p> <p>Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year. player who is accepted into a tournament, withdraws from the entire competition for any reason whatsoever within 7 (seven) days before the first scheduled match of the tournament, the Member Association entering the player shall make a payment of EURO100.— to BADMINTON EUROPE.</p> <p>player, during the season, withdraws from more than 3 tournaments within the last 7 days before the beginning of the tournament the Member Association entering such a player will make a payment of € 500.-- to BADMINTON EUROPE.</p>
